Founded in 2018 and registered with the CAC in 2021, Atycare Initiative (ACI) recognizes that there are a lot of shortcomings in the education of children in Africa. Therefore, ACI is a passion-driven development organization with passion and empathy concerning access to Education, Economic empowerment, psycho-social support, Gender Equality, Basic health care, Knowledge Development, and Management in Nigeria. ACI is conscientious in reaching out to Women, Orphans, and Vulnerable Children (OVC) and Youth in hard-to-reach communities and remote villages - for we envision a society where children develop into functional and productive adults.

We create educational scholarships, and women empowerment, create safe learning spaces to improve learning outcomes, and provide psycho-social support for under-deserve children in hard-to-reach rural communities.

This is achieved by collaborating with the government, private sectors, individuals, civil society organizations (CBOs), and other developmental agencies toward building a sustainable network. Most importantly, by building a network of a socially responsible community of dependent volunteers committed to social reformation.

The year 2021 had been another thrilling year for Atycare Initiative (ACI). As a passion-driven organization, it strengthened our efforts on the creative impact on the society such as "Project 1000 Children" which ensured that we gave access to quality education to 1000 out-of-school children who return to school through the provision of essential educational resources (school uniforms, sandals, bags, socks, school fees, and writing materials). Some other models such as Gender-based related intervention programs such as 16days of Activism where we used social media for advocacy and campaigns, Secondary School sensitization on SGBV, and virtual training on Social Inclusion and SGBV which were effectively rounded up with their share of achievements, learning, and scope for improvisation.

ACI has also arrived at the indispensable role of providing Food to widows and orphaned children in the rural communities, which has been observed as critical not only from the aspect of health but also as a factor that contributes to effective learning.


